INCLEMENT WEATHER UPDATE: Legacy Community Health Clinics Closed for In-Person Visits Tuesday and Wednesday

HOUSTON - (January 19, 2025) Due to expected inclement weather on Tuesday, January 21 and Wednesday, January 22, all Legacy clinics and pharmacies will be closed.

School-Based Health locations will follow the schedules of YES Prep, KIPP and Galena Park ISD schools on Tuesday and Wednesday.

For tomorrow, Monday January 20, with the exception of the Legacy Southwest Clinic's Pediatric Walk-In Clinic (6441 High Star Drive), **all Legacy clinics and pharmacies will be closed on Martin Luther King, Jr. Day**. Tomorrow our Southwest Clinic's Pediatric Walk-In will be open from 10:00 am - 6:00 pm, unless conditions change.
